

you enter, the bedroom has a wet bar and a door that leads to the master bathroom.

This bathroom has a triangular shaped tub in the corner to your left as you enter the room. The windows on the two walls of this corner provide a great view of the lake. On the wall in front is a large shower. This is one of the few showers with a window which looks outside



to the lawn beside the house. There is a door on the wall to your right that provides access to a large walk-in closet. This closet also connects to John's office.

On the opposite side of the house, you enter the boys' wing from the foyer into a media room complete with six theater recliners. As you enter the room, to your right, is a sliding glass door that leads to a large sun-deck. This sundeck has a covered pavilion so you can enjoy the sun or the shade. There is a huge patio below it, that has a large built-in fire pit and beyond that is the lake.

In the media room, on the opposite wall from the sliding glass door, is a big screen television. To the left of the television is an entranceway to a kitchenette and to the right of the television is an entranceway to a half bath. The wall that is in front of you as you enter the media room has doors that lead to Josh's and Joe's bedrooms. Each bedroom has its own full bathroom.

Fantastic great room

The house was designed around a wonderful great room. The Keys designed the house themselves along with a PC architecture program. They consulted a designer and architect to complete the project but from the beginning they wanted a large great room with a panoramic view. They knew exactly where it should sit on the property. A large rock formation that actually protrudes out was the perfect place for the house.

The great room is shaped like a semi-circle and sits on the outer most edge of the rock formation. Windows cover the curved front which provides you with a fabulous unobstructed three-sided view of the lake. A large sectional sofa sits in this area of the room. If you stand next to this sofa and face the back of the room you will see that the spiral staircase descends down from the foyer on the left side of the room to the living area of the room which has comfortable furniture ar-

ranged to make a stacked rock fireplace its focal point. All the colors and furnishings flow well. Jennifer gives all the credit to her interior decorator, Luann Mann of Mann Interiors of Huntsville.



To your right on this same wall is the large open kitchen. It has stainless steel appliances and marble countertops. It is separated from the great room by a large bar that seats eight. A hallway between the living area and the kitchen provides access to a guest bedroom on the left side of the hall and a large pantry on the right side. A full bath and wine cellar are located down the hallway as is the elevator that leads to the foyer upstairs.

An area behind the kitchen is where the regular staircase descends from the foyer upstairs. It ends in a hallway that is on the opposite side of the kitchen from the other hallway. This hall also has a full bath, laundry room, separate powder room and a door that leads out to the garage. To the right of this garage door is a glass door that provides access to a patio outside that holds a large built-in fire pit.

The garage has actually been decorated. It has lots of windows and is used as a sunroom. A huge built-in grill makes this a phenomenal place to entertain, especially when the Keys open the large garage door that covers one whole wall. There is also a separate fireplace in the garage to provide warmth during the winter months.

There is an outdoor shower near the garage door which is great for cleaning up after working in the many flower beds that are found all around the house. The landscape designer, Carol Bloodworth from Green Lizard Landscaping, has done a superb job. From the massive rock fountain located in the middle of the circular drive down to the smallest detail of purple ajuga groundcover, everything is lovely and feels natural. The
